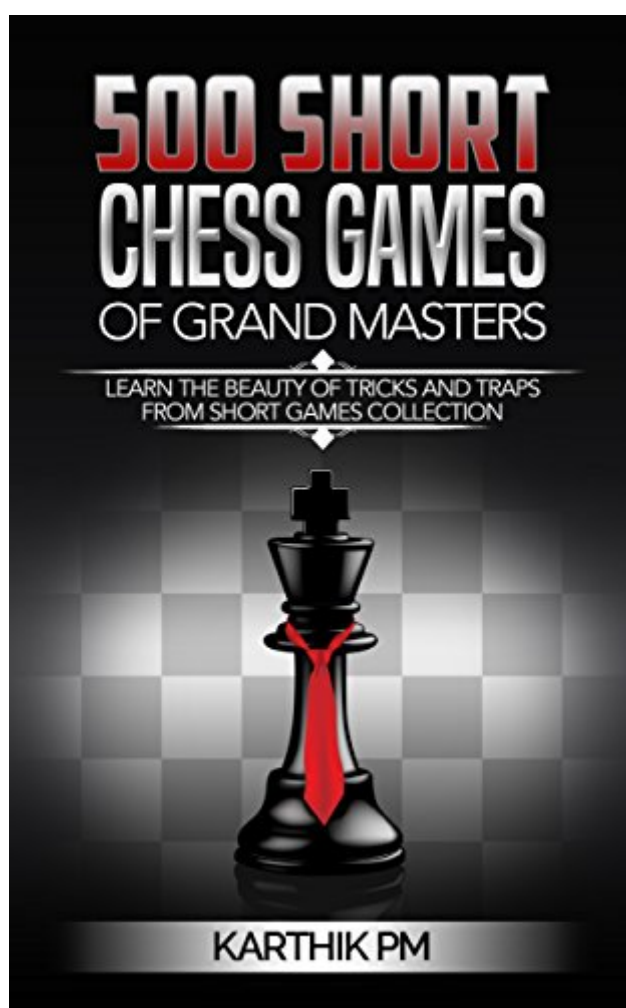

I would recommend beginners to have a board while going through these games, intermediate and advanced players try to imagine the game as long as possible as it improves your visualization technique drastically.

The book claims it is suitable for beginners. Not sure how this is since its not a teaching book, its just data dump. The book claims will give you an idea on how to improve your play. How is this possible when they dont even tell you the opening or when the error occurred. The book claims it will make it easier to interpret and understand tactics? How there is no discussion in this book. To mention of tactics, key movements, mistakes etc. it is just a data dump. i have attached a picture for you to see for your self. Do Not recommend this book.

Contains only the numbers of the moves, which maybe I should have realized. (I am not a chess player, it was a gift.)

Very poor. He doesn't explain anything

No diagrams and no discussions. This is definitely for strong intermediate and advanced players

There are some typos that need to be corrected

There are no diagrams or commentary for each of the games. There is adequate space, however, to jot comments about a particular game. I have written in the reason for a resignation, as an example. I have Chernev's book, "1000 Short Games of Chess" but this collection is more contemporary.

Reading this book is akin to watching one of these amazing grand masters in action. Its clearly a book meant for the more advanced player so the author saw no need to include diagrams. These are great moves to study and use as your own during chess games.
