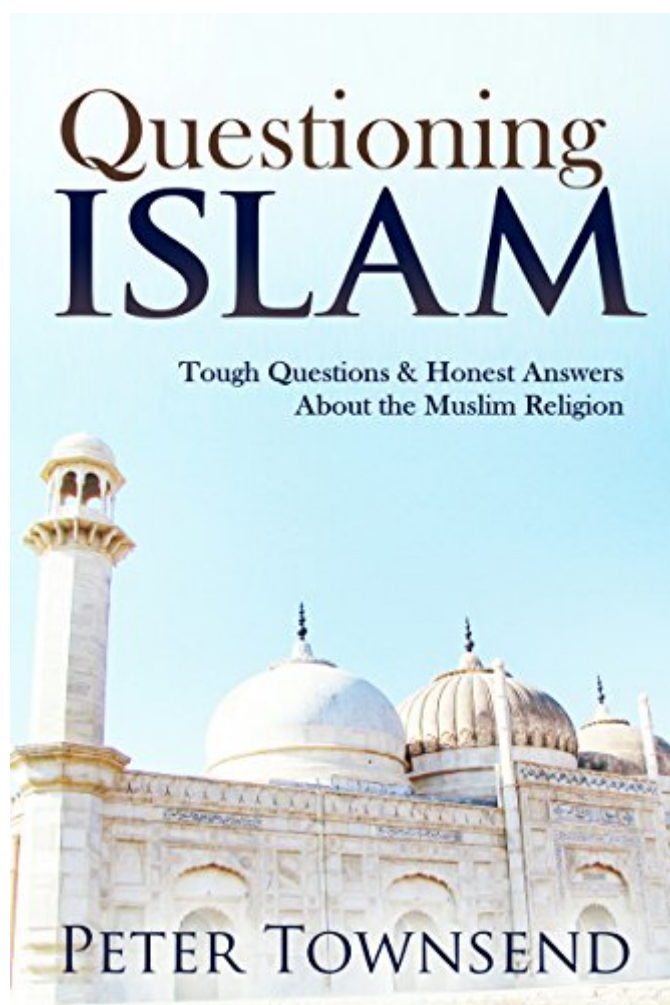

Instead Questioning Islam goes straight to the classic sources of Islam namely the Qur'an, hadiths (traditions) and biographies of Muhammad. Questioning Islam is not an attempt to promote any other belief system or ideology. Its focus is simply on asking the hard questions about Islam that are all too often ignored or swept under the carpet. Simply put, if you have ever wondered whether the truth-claims of Islam can withstand critical scrutiny then this book is for you!

Townsend does an excellent job of research using the authoritative versions of the Qur'an, the strongest of the Hadiths and the biography of Mohammad accepted as authoritative by most Muslim scholars. For those who don't know, the Hadiths are the traditions of Mohammad and his companions which Islamic scholars say are essential to understand and practice Islam. Sunnis and Shi'a accept different ones as being the strongest, but for example, the Muslim declaration of faith (There is no god but Allah and Mohammad is his prophet, and the other four "Pillars of Islam" are in the Hadiths, not the Qur'an. He also uses archeological evidence and other writings from the time of Mohammad and of the Hadiths (like the Qur'an, written down decades, often centuries, after Mohammad died) to question much of Islam history and teaching. He tends to use both superlatives ("Jaw Dropping" revelation) and slightly pejorative language (Muslim apologists) which I think do not strengthen the book. Nevertheless, this is well worth reading and will give you a strong background in both Islamic history and the claims of the Muslim religion.

Nothing should be accepted without critical thought, including religious beliefs; to accept anything at all without evidence is simply baseless superstition. Peter Townsend with Questioning Islam has subjected the Koran (Qur'an) and Islamic beliefs in general to critical examination and found many features that are internally contradictory, have been shown by modern science to be false, simply make no sense, or have been proven wrong by history and archaeology. One can only hope that at least a few Muslims, or people who are considering converting to Islam, have sufficiently open minds to read Questioning Islam and give Peter's arguments some serious thought. I suspect that most Muslims will be too committed to their beliefs, and too frightened of questioning them, to read the book. It is fear of damnation in anyone who questions his or her faith that gives Islam (and

Christianity for that matter) its hold over its adherents.
