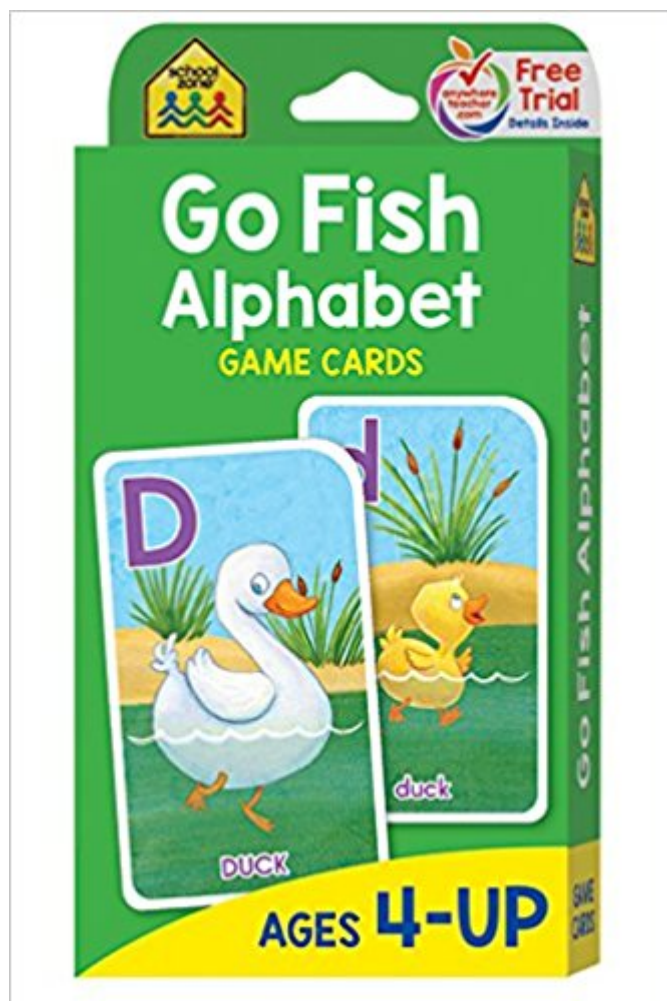

Some people will complain that the cards are too big for kids to hold but just as many will say they liked that the cards were big. It didn't bother me either way. Mostly, we played a matching game on the ground. I don't think these are really that great for teaching letter but more for reinforcing them. It's best to teach kids capital letters first (and out of order). Adding lower case in is confusing. Also, I found my son quickly just looked at the pictures and not the letters. You could make these at home easy enough. It's an adult animal on the capital card and their baby on the lowercase. If you have a

toddler, maybe they would pick up some of the letters as a by-product but I don't recommend as a teaching tool specifically.

I bought these because of the great price but I had no idea how much my daughter would love them. They got played with so many times in the first 2 days that I ended up laminating them (they are a kind of cheap cardboard material). I would absolutely recommend these, they are a huge hit!

I purchased this Go Fish game to play with my three-year-old twin sons. I have looked at other "Go Fish" cards but was always disappointed that the cards consisted of several species of fish -- this is too complicated for my 3-year-olds. These cards are great as all the cards contain animals (that go along with the corresponding letter, e.g. T is for turtle) that my children can match. However, you can also match the cards by matching the uppercase to lowercase letter. My sons are just starting to recognize lowercase letters so not only do we have fun playing this game, but they are also learning while we play. The cards are also larger than regular-sized playing cards.

These are great to help my 4-year-old learn and have fun. She makes me play with her all the time. They were delivered quickly.

My step-son is 4, a precarious age where he is beginning to sound out letters. These cards were perfect for him. There are fun animals with the letter in the corner (both an uppercase with the matching lowercase--maybe a little advanced for him, but great for his big brother). And it's surprising how hard it is to think of an animal for every letter, so I will forgive the Yaks and Narwhals.

Under 2 bucks shipped (with Prime of course) Hard to complain. I like them for my 3-year-old. Helps him learn. Cards are slightly bigger than standard cards which can be a little hassle as he can't hold them in his hand and see them all (fanning them out like a poker player, if you will...) Also, only other gripe (I'm trying hard) is the cards are based on animals, etc. For example. The "A" card may have an alligator on it. Makes sense. The "X" has a Fox and the X is underlined. I can see how they may have to do that, but... Like I said, that's my biggest complaint. 5 stars from me. Buy it!

My 5-year-old grand-daughter loves to play this game with me. Helping her with letter recognition while we have fun.

Kids loved. Had a blast playing. The only thing I wish that was also provided would be a set of cards showing the capital letters like it has showing the lower case letter.
