

This book definitely entices you to want to explore LA.As an extensive traveler, mostly solo through my life, just a quick safety & navigation tip.Never take a map in public to find your way around, it SCREAMS to criminals, please take my stuff while I'm distracted. You could get pick pocketed & never know bc someone bumped into you while you were looking at your map. What I did before phones was, investigate where I wanted to go & write it down with cross streets so,I could ask for directions without saying I'm going to a hotel or the like. What I do now is, use Google maps on my phone, star my places of interest & put in walk mode. Lets me be aware of my surroundings & also familiarize where I'm going. Just a tip, from a cop's daughter. While this book is a great starting point, I'm giving 5 stars based on what it is, but travel is about expanding your mind so, go to local websites or other travel sites to complete the picture & while your there. Be in the moment & ask a shopkeeper or server where they like to go. You'll have a blast !

Though I am now an evolving midwesterner expat from LA, I'm still very familiar with the region. I'm not sure ANY guide book can cover a city as large and complex as Los Angeles (this book also includes parts behind the Orange Curtain), but this is 288 pages of what appears to be very

accurate and full of very useful information. I personally recommend ignoring the hotel and restaurant recommendations and depend upon the locals to take you to their favorite places. Many of the local mom and pop restaurants are far superior (and cheaper) than a lot of the recommendations.

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
