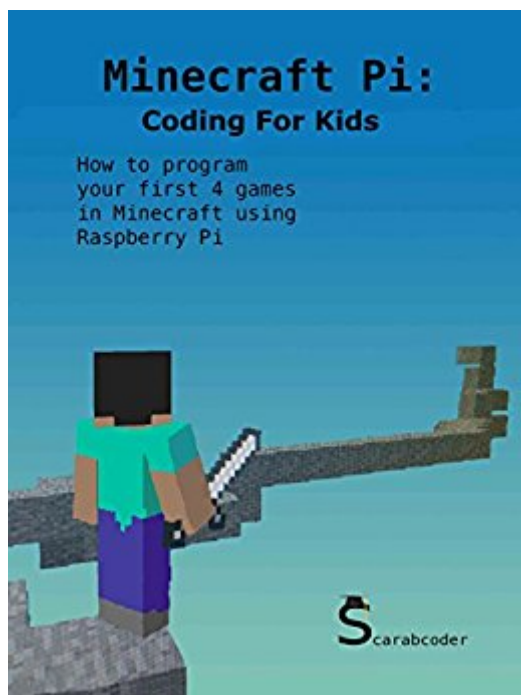

I am a parent and software engineer with a 9 year old that keeps bugging me about wanting to learn how to code games. I have tried to get him going at the ground level with learning the basics of data types, structures, looping, and conditionals, but lets face it most people reading this review just glazed over with this sentence and so did my son. This book is fairly inexpensive, is written at the correct level for my son, and conveniently skips some of the boring details. With my first read

through I think it will be the perfect guide for my son to get started with, but will take some side by side interaction because there are a lot of assumptions that the person has a certain level ability with a linux, RPI system, and coding in general.

This book is the best for what it does. But one small issue occurred, when making the world edit, it said a float was required. If it says that to you, just put this for line 16 in the api.py file:
