

I purchased this when it was first released in 1985; and it is still on my bookcase Twenty Seven years later. There were two; "In Private, In Public - The Prince and Princess of Wales," and this one "In Person - The Prince and Princess of Wales." There was also a video released in conjunction w/ the books. The family allowed Tim Graham to follow them for a year from 1985 - 86. I believe the reasoning was to dispel the rumors which had already begun to circulate regarding the state of their marriage; but what was more prevalent in the video; yet still noticeable in the pictures was the strain between Charles and Diana; @ times it was impossible for them to hide their discomfort. This contains some of the most intimate shots of Diana and the boy's when they were young; and shots of Highgrove House and what were to be the beginnings of Charles' award winning gardens. The Princess always said she wanted the boys to experience as much of a normal life as other children their age; so in that light, I was not surprised to see in their backyard a playhouse just like the one I had for my daughter. It is evident from the images which fill this book that she adored her boys; and their love for one another.Looking back now it's tragic seeing how happy they were then; and that

they had so little time left together. I highly recommend this to anyone interested in the British Royal Family, you won't be disappointed.
