

Bok, a philosophy teacher at Brandeis University, discusses her mother's life and accomplishments in this new addition to the "Radcliffe Biography" series. She chronicles Alva's Swedish childhood, her elopement with an economics student, Gunnar Myrdal, who later won the Nobel Prize in economics, her career in the Swedish goverment and the United Nations, and her involvement in the international disarmament movement that won her the 1982 Nobel Peace Prize. The best part is Bok's highly personal and insightful commentary on her mother's life and life choices, which were unusual and even scandalous at the time but seem commonplace to us now. She also includes many excerpts from letters and other family papers, providing a fascinating look into an unusual and special family.
