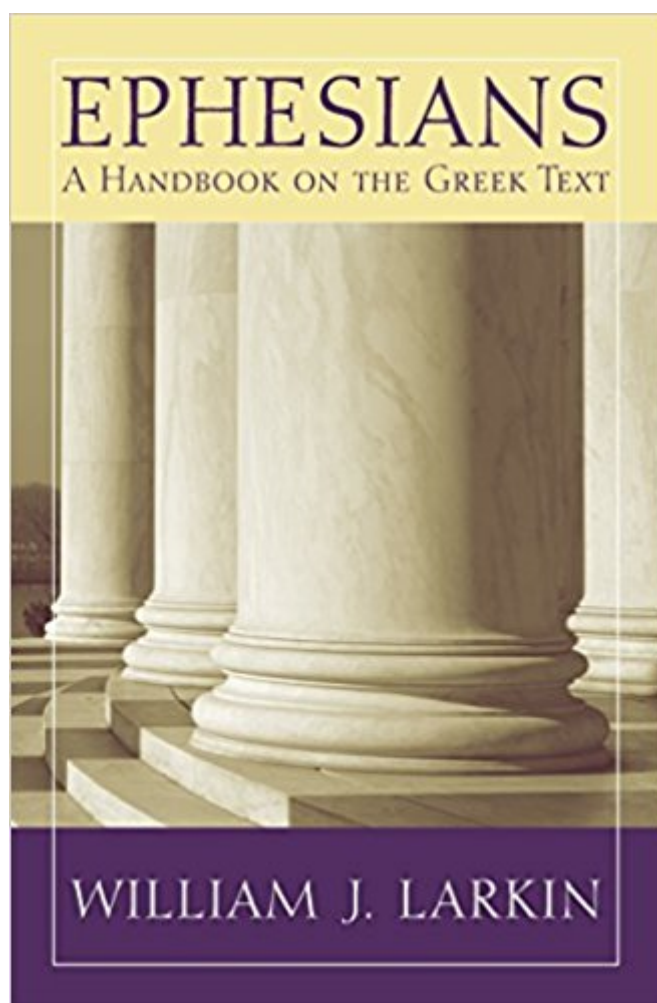

William J. Larkin (1945-2014) (Ph.D. University of Durham) was Professor of New Testament and Greek, Columbia International University, Seminary and School of Missions. He was the author of *Greek is Great Gain: A Method for Exegesis and Exposition and Culture and Biblical Hermeneutics: Interpreting and Applying the Authoritative Word in a Relativistic Age*.

Dr. Larkin provides a grammatical analysis on every word in the text - nouns, verbs, infinitives, participles, articles, conjunctions, etc. It is a very helpful tool and I appreciated it a lot. It should not become a crutch. It is not a commentary or a kind of work that examines the literary features of Ephesians. As I translated and determined the syntax, I would check Dr. Larkin's work and appreciated the times when I saw possibilities that I hadn't thought about. This is an excellent series.
