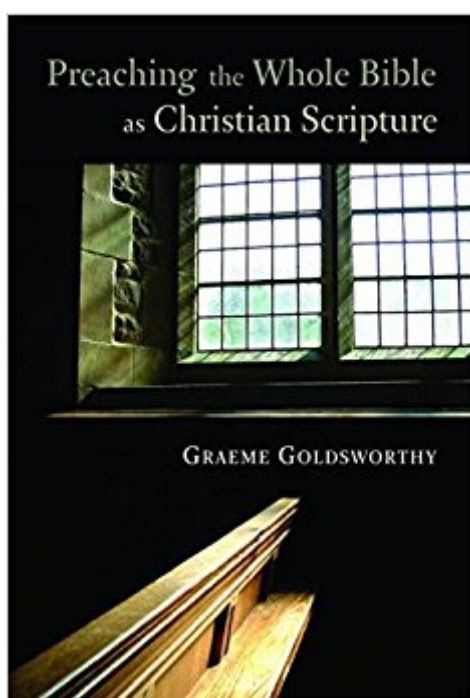

Goldsworthy first examines the Bible, biblical theology, and preaching and shows how they relate in the preparation of Christ-centered sermons. He then applies the biblical-theological method to the various types of literature found in the Bible, drawing out their contributions to expository preaching focused on the person and work of Christ. Clear, complete, and immediately applicable, this volume will become a fundamental text for teachers, pastors, and students preparing for ministry.

As a Pentecostal Pastor I have great appreciation for this work by a Reformed minister. Too often ministers in my circles either downplay the OT or they make it man centered instead of christ centered. The book strictly demands that all scripture be interpreted by the hermenutic of the gospel message, something I strongly agree with. In the first half he develops his arguements. In the second he shows how this can be practically applied to different genres of Biblical writting.

Graeme Goldsworthy is one of those authors who should spend his entire life just writing about the subject he so dearly loves. Not only did I find Preaching the Whole Bible as Christian Scripture, I was enthralled from start to finish. Goldsworthy is rightly named, for his knowledge of this subject seems to be without limit. I read the book for a second time, just to experience for a second time the sheer pleasure of his writing.

Reading this book gave me a new perspective on the Old Testament. Previous to this, I had so often heard sermons on OT passages that left me feeling, 'that's interesting, but... so what?' Just this week I heard a sermon on 1 Kings 1, and left feeling like I had received some history and morality lessons, but that's about all. To understand the whole of the OT as preparing the way for Christ opens out a new vista in the OT. Now I see pre-Christ shadows in the call of Jeremiah, Solomon's first act as king, Joshua destroying idols, Moses leading the exodus... This is very important for anyone with any teaching responsibility, and will inject a new vitality into their OT teaching and preaching.

Goldsworthy's book is of enormous value to any Christian preacher who desires to be faithful in handling the whole counsel of God. At a minimum it should be read to refute unhelpful views that limit our exposition of Old Testament scripture. When well applied, Goldsworthy's principles will reveal in preaching from any text our God in fullest measure. Particularly helpful is the latter section of practical application to preaching according to genre.

Shows the need and reality of preaching the WHOLE counsel of God. Every pastor should have a copy and read it and take it to heart.
