This is a "coming of age" story with twists and surprises. The twins are very talented wizards but don't know how to wield their powers. They're

immediately thrown into danger when their parents are kidnapped and must join their "Uncle Benny" and his friends in a desperate quest to rescue their parents. Before they can be properly trained, they're faced with scary creatures that test their skills. An evil wizard, Tardon wants to rule of all the worlds and plans to use the twins to achieve his goal. Will Jack be able to control his raging emotions and learn how to become a leader? He's sure Benny is hiding something and he's right. Anger and frustration make Jack a dangerous ally in the battle they must fight to save the worlds. Will Maddie's eagerness to trust put her into greater danger? This first book of the trilogy sets the scene for an epic fantasy series. Start it today.

Great story with an amazing writing style that makes the reading fun and compelling. There is plenty of mystery, action and supernatural to satisfy readers of all ages.

I met Cris Pasquerelle in an author group, and he asked me to purchase and review this book. *Destiny Revealed* is a middle-grade fantasy featuring Jack and Maddie, a pair of magical thirteen-year-olds from a parallel world. In the opening chapters, they learn they are magical in response to the kidnapping of their parents by the power-hungry megalomaniac Tardon. They are

supported by their uncle, Benny, who carries them into their home-world for the first time and tries to teach them magic, along with his apprentice, Connie, and an allied group of forest-guarding gnomes. Over time, as the twins' magical powers spontaneously manifest in response to difficult situations, Jack becomes protective and aggressive, actually taking the lead of a group of wizards and gnomes who oppose Tardon and are trying to save the kidnapped parents, while Maddie continues to try to be nice and develops some closeness with their aunt, whose loyalties are known to be questionable from the beginning. A huge climactic battle serves as a setup for future books in the same series. The book moves at a fast clip, with new characters and situations arising constantly and with conflict and adventure on every page. Its storyline and characterization make it well-suited to a middle grade audience (ages 11-13). Pasqueralle thrives most when moving the story forward, and tries hard to create complicated and likeable characters. The book is well-edited, with no grammatical problems and only one or two typos that are not especially annoying. Because of the fast pace and dialogue-driven, functional style of the book, I finished it in three sittings over two days.
