

Chaos: I Bring the Fire part III is a tragically fast read but then again when the story is excellent it always seems that way. My favorite thing about this novel and the rest of the series are the characters. Ms. Gockel has created a set of characters that are dynamic and lovable. I read these novels because I truly care about what happens to these characters. The heroine, Amy, is an admirable and refreshing character. In a world filled with whiny, finicky, and indecisive heroines, Amy stands out as an intelligent person who actually lives up to the job of a HEROine without becoming the stereotypical action heroine or damsel in distress. Loki is not the stereotypical charming rogue that seduces girls and becomes the reluctant or unwitting hero. He is a well rounded character that has incredible depth and emotions. He has an actual history that has a definite impact on the character we see in the novel. Something that really impresses me about Gockel's Loki is the fact that even after three novels he still retains an air of mystery, which I suppose lives up to his chaotic and unpredictable nature. The supporting cast of characters are equally well written. Thor, Steve Rogers (not Captain America), Beatrice, etc help move the story along without leaving a cluttered feeling. Also Thor is freaking hilarious and I love the fact that Ms. Gockel has borrowed some names from the popular Marvel movies and comics. The second thing that I truly love about this story is the complexity. Gockel weaves more than just Norse mythology into Chaos. She touches on Hindu and threads science into the story to enrich it. Even though this is the third book in the series it kept me guessing about what was going to happen. Each little bit and

piece provides clues but the full picture isn't really seen until the end. Furthermore, the action is fast paced with no time to allow the reader to think that it is a good stopping place for the night. Whether its action, romantic tension, or the small moments where the characters make a discovery, you will not want to put this book down. I would definitely recommend this book and the series to anyone who is looking for a good fantasy read but is burnt out on "contemporary" or "paranormal" fantasy. Those who enjoy the Marvel movies and comics would probably also enjoy the series as well. I will also wait on the edge of my seat for next book in the series.

This was a satisfying conclusion to the Loki part of this story cycle. Though I still found the narrative a bit rough in places, I cared enough about the characters to read to the end. I missed the sections of Loki's backstory that made the second book so poignant, but I did enjoy seeing Loki's and Amy's relationship evolve. Altogether, a clever and original plot with compelling characters.

There aren't many books that hook me, but this first one did. I have become addicted to this series and cannot read it fast enough. I am eager to finish the other books. If you enjoy fantasy novels, I suggest you give it a go. The books aren't long and they do tend to cliffhanger but that doesn't bother me. This book contains no sex scenes, and virtually no swearing. That said, it has adult situations, and mentions of mythological tales. Interesting twist on the myths. Loki is the HERO. It was great to see Loki personified in these books. The characters are richly drawn and it is easy to suspend disbelief about the existence of gods and magic. The slow reveal of more and more Norse mythology tie-ins to current day life was just really cool. Ms. Gockel is proof that the self published authors can put out something every bit as good as the big name publishers. I'm keeping this author on my watch list.

I read so much I have a hard tie getting into a series because in all honesty, just like fashion it has been done before. I am not typically into sci-fi / fantasy, I use to be a huge mystery series fan but as mentioned most of what is being written in the mystery/thriller genre has been done before and unless the writer is really spectacular I find myself "skim" reading just because I hate not finishing a book. I find this series different, and while not in a category I normally gravitate to, I am really glad I found it. I love the series , the characters are well developed and I have looked forward to each boo. I am reading 3.5 and can't to read 4 thru 6....The only sad bit is that when I am done, I will have to spend more agonizing hours to find a new series that is as good this one.
