

This board book only really entertains my son with the noises and buttons. There really isn't a story to the book, it's more of a made up description of each type of R2 droid. It is detail that is more interesting to an older kid that...WOULDN'T be buying a board book to get that detail. I think the author didn't fully think through who the target audience is for board books when creating this book. It's disappointing to get books that you can't really read to your kid that don't hold their attention. I've ended up making up my own stories while flipping through this book and letting my kid press the buttons to add in sound effects. This is the kind of book that makes me think I could become an author.

What a fun book! It is set up like a children's "board" book with thick pages and the batter-operated R2-D2 shaped sound unit. As you read, you press a numbered button to hear R2's sounds and the book tells you the translation. The art is whimsical and cute and the text is fun. I think even an adult collector of Star Wars with a sense of humor would enjoy this book; I don't think it's for kids only. With R2-D2 set to be in the new movies It's probably really important to brush up on our droid communication skills...

I purchased this book for my 6 month old girl. Yes she is too young to read the book, but nonetheless, she loves it. The hard pages are easy for her to turn and she can't rip them up like regular book page. She loves the R2D2 on the front and it has been great fun watching her learn how to press the buttons. (Though I wish it had an off switch) The content of the book is interesting although I felt it left a little to be desired. It really doesn't have much to it as far as story, it's just a bunch of scenarios that have an R2 unit speaking in some situation. The book directs you to push some buttons to make the R2 unit say some sort of saying. The artwork is cleaver although I found a few of the pages to be rather bland or downright awkward. Overall, a great buy and I would certainly purchase it again.
