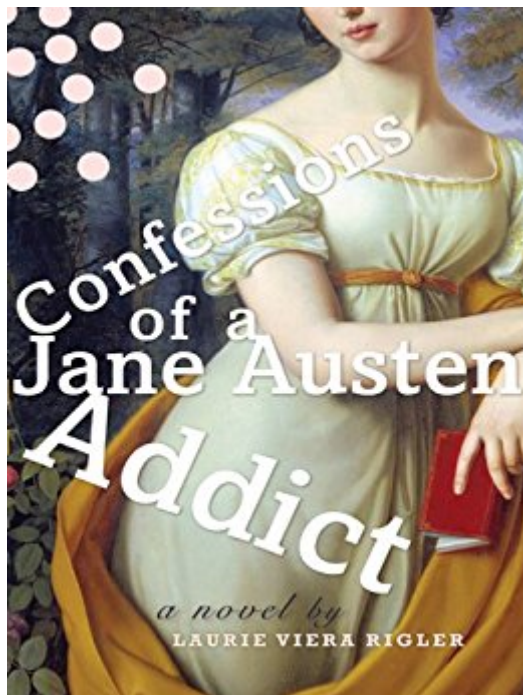

I read the sequel first, and gave it 5 stars. Because I'm very much a Regency personality making my way through a 21st century life. I could identify with the protagonist learning to "pass" and then thrive in a culture not her own. So perhaps the many reviewers who would give the first book 5 stars and the second one 3 stars felt the other way when reading it; they were 21st century readers trying to imagine how they would have dealt in Jane Austen's world. And the ones who gave those reviews probably imagine they could have managed things better than that protagonist. I enjoyed reading this series for what it taught me about my own attitudes--and that outcome was a total surprise. I'd just wanted entertainment and got enlightenment.

I have only recently been re-introduced to Jane Austen, her writing and her life. Soon after, I discovered this book and ordered it right away. I've had this book for months now but just had not gotten around to starting it, until last week. I finally had the opportunity and once I started, I didn't want to put it down! Of course, I have little time to read so it took longer to finish than it should have but I've found myself making time to read, which I haven't done in a very long time. I absolutely loved reading this book, which was inspired by the writings of Jane Austen and included many references to Miss Austen's books and characters.
