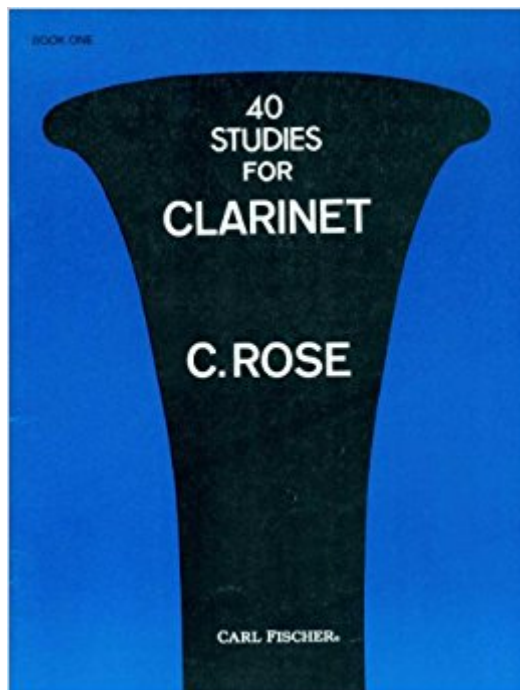

An excellent book filled with exercises that will help anyone become a better player. There is also a later edition, published about 1988, which has a page describing techniques for each exercise which is very useful for the less-experienced player. But the exercises are the same in each version and will challenge all but the most experienced players.
