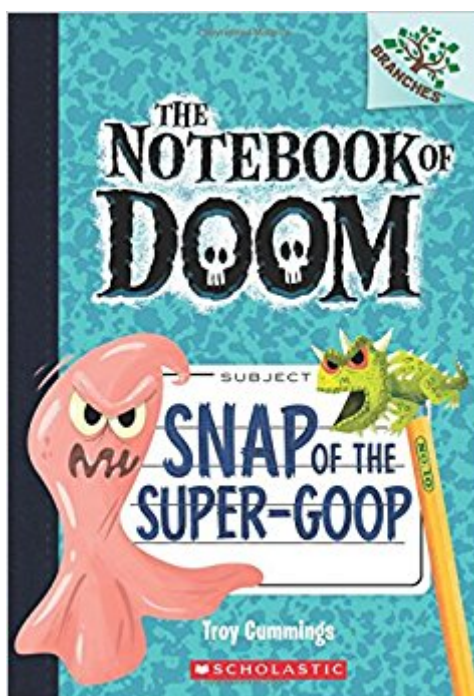

My son is a HUGE fan of Troy Cummings and the Notebook of Doom series. They are hard to find as I have only seen them sold at his school book fairs once a year. They are also \$5 a piece so I enjoyed the little bit of a discount that I got. These are great mystery style chapter books for beginners. They really engage the reader which is important for a young child. They aren't too big as to discourage them from wanting to read yet they aren't too childish either. I highly recommend the Notebook of Doom series for any child that likes to read fiction books about monsters and monster fighters.

My son loves this series and has been collecting each book. We have the entire series and will order the next one that's coming out end of June. He started reading this series when he was about 8, maybe 9 and is now 11 and still wants any new books that come out. (He is also very into the Diary of a Wimpy Kid now too) He is a very reluctant reader and the Notebook of Doom series was the 1st series of books he willingly read and even asked for! And he wanted to own them too and not just borrow from the library, lol. Anytime I can find books that my son actually WANTS to read I'm thrilled!! And they are AR books that he can quizzes on in school!

I ordered these books for my son for Christmas. They arrived well packaged and undamaged. Fast shipping which was nice. He loves these books! I have not read them but our son read one to my husband and he said they were really fun books. Our son is 9 and hates to read! He is an excellent
