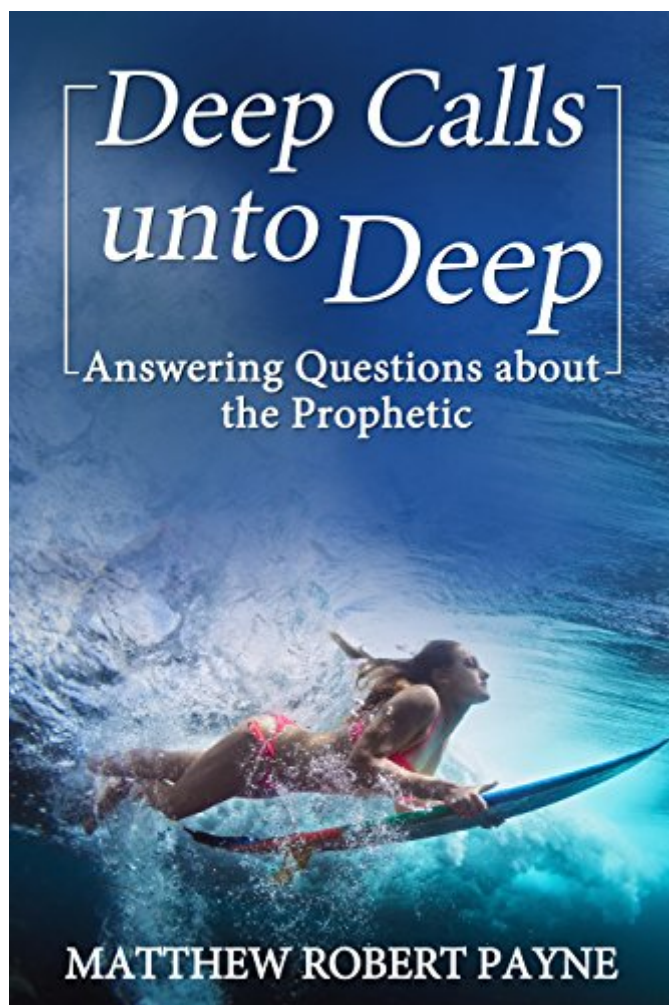

They don't see the sacrifices the prophet makes—the self-denial, days of fasting and giving up friendships that don't promote a godly lifestyle. This

Ok, read the book exactly halfway. There definitely is some good to be gotten from the book, the testimony. However there are a lot of red flags, that makes me weary. I hope the author reads this. In his book, it's as if I can sense his loneliness, and pain or hurt for love. It almost feels like some of his motives are rooted in pain, rather than in abundance of life. The biggest issue that I'm having, is that he constantly tries to convince the reader, that he's a prophet. A self proclaimed prophet can operate in prophecy, but does not have the office of a prophet. Prophets, though lone wolves, should never operate alone. Also, the word of God comes. We can't fabricate it. A prophet that will speak a word over people like that, with or without pay, is as apostate as Moses clashing his staff on the rocks. It cost him the promised land. The Lord reveals and impresses. The moment you try to suck the word out of where the Lord does not speak, you're fabricating lies. So I have a hard time believing in this. Even Jesus said "freely you received, freely you give". Lastly, I followed up on some of the web pages and name of the author, and it brings me to websites glorifying angels, and miracles. Like a sect, there are a lot of red flags that one needs to be aware of, before reading. I personally believe the man has had roots in the occult, and some of them are still showing, despite his change of the past decades. I don't know him, at all, but my hunch usually is right. Not to defame the writer, but to bring caution to who wants To grow in God, be careful, there's a lot of bitter water with the fresh... Tread with caution, and pray over what the Lord wants you to remember...
