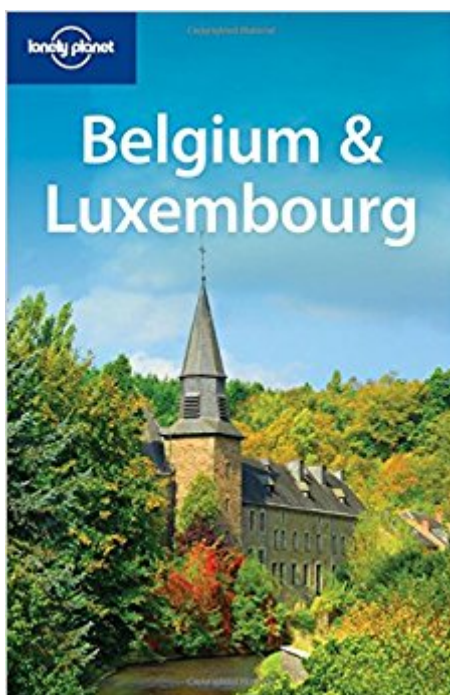

I love Lonely Planet guide books, I've travelled all over the world, and they are my go to guidebooks. This is the first ebook that I've bought though, and I will never buy another one unless the layout is dramatically changed. It is hopeless to navigate and find what you're after. And the maps. Really. I don't understand why the maps can't be easily accessible. I have a kindle because I don't want to carry printouts of maps and travel notes with me. I've used Lonely Planet PDFs on my kindle before, and they are much much better. Actual books are by far the easiest to navigate, but I'm trying to

minimise what I carry with me. It really seems like no effort at all was made in trying to make this ebook user friendly, and I wouldn't recommend to anybody to buy it, go with the PDFs.

Love lonely planet paper editions from many years on the road. This is my first experience with the Kindle version. The information in the guide is good, if a bit outdated. We have been in Belgium for a month and have mostly done our traveling as tag-alongs with friends who are Flanders natives. They concurred with listings and highlights. The real let-down is that this book is very difficult to use as a kindle edition since it lacks any city listing or index in the table of contents. Finding an entry, even for major cities like Gent or Antwerp, requires a laborious search and page through. A serious annoyance that happened every single time we wanted to use the guide. Not sure if I would purchase again.
