

Very Good

Reading the annotated games is a good way to get some insights into what is important in a given position. The only reason I do not give it 5 stars is that I am missing a more in-depth explanation of the more technical aspects. E.g., how to decide between building a prime or hitting your opponent. The variation of the discussions in the book is limited to snap shot positions and the theoretical side would benefit from an explanation based on positions that were not necessarily in the games commented. I know this would break with the format of the book and that this is an old book, but this is where I think more value is to be gained.
