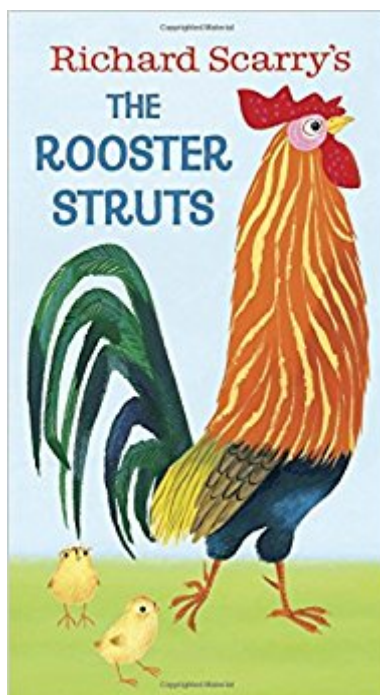

No other illustrator has shown such a lively interest in the words and concepts of early childhood. He began his career at Golden Books in the 1940s, and he remains one of the world's best-loved children's authors EVER! He was posthumously awarded a Lifetime Achievement Award from the Society of Illustrators in 2012.

Bought for my 15 month old granddaughter. she loves the pictures, and board books are great for chewing on when we tire of the pictures. Richard Scarry's sweet illustrations have been charming for at least the 45 years since I started reading his books to the children I babysat, and they still are.

Very engaging for babies with short attention spans! There's something about the illustrations that my 11 month old loves. Text on each page is one sentence only, which is perfect for her right now. Buy this together with I Am A Bunny.

This board book has nice big colorful pictures. It's like Richard Scarry doing paintings as opposed to his usual, slightly less rich and detailed stuff. I love it. It's a simple book that only addresses a few animals and with a sentence as simple as the title.

After seeing how much my baby loved 'I am a Bunny' I purchased this book. He now loves this one, too. The wording is a little more simpler than 'I am a Bunny' and it has great vibrant pictures. He's loved 'I am Bunny' from about 6 months old and I got 'The Rooster Struts' for him around 9 months. He liked it then and still likes it at 11 months old. He wants me to read it to him every day. :)

I love the quality of the artwork but found the story line missing. This book expands a child's vocabulary in describing how the various animals move by using words like: struts, waddles, swings

My 22 month old loves this book. The pictures are beautiful. It describes different ways of movement. He get's a kick out of it when we are doing the motions as we are reading.
