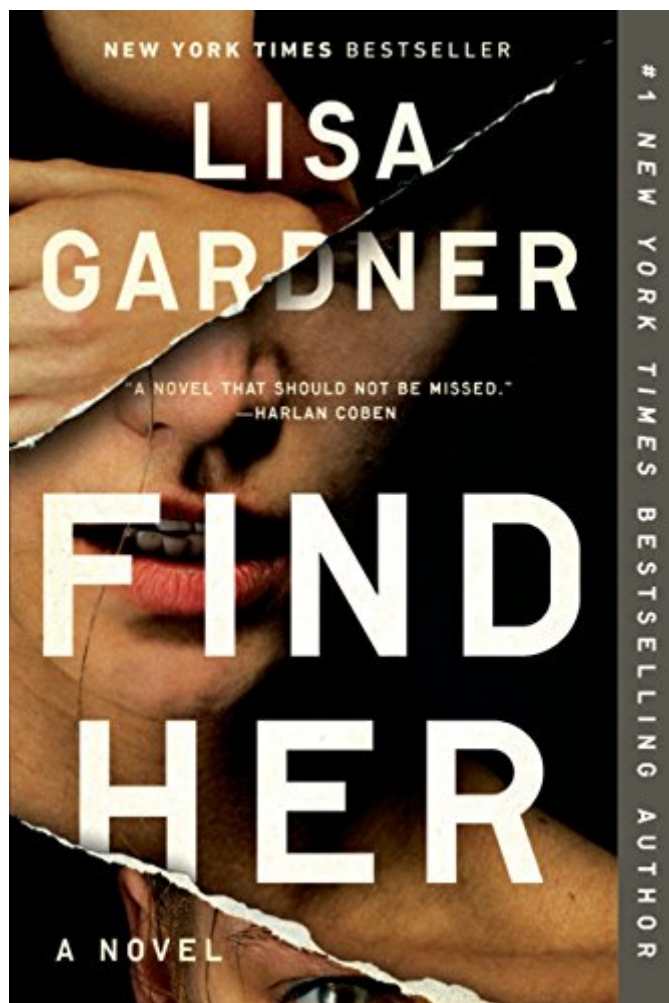

This is a must-read novel! Lisa Gardner has risen to the challenge of how to write books that are increasingly more compelling. Find Her involves D.D. Warren whose investigation brings in a young woman named Flora, who was kidnapped and held captive for over a year. Is she a vigilante or in the wrong place at the wrong time? What I loved most about this novel is the description of the relationship between Flora and her captor. Flora is a prisoner, but she's grateful for anything her captor gives her. She's a prisoner, but doesn't take advantages of opportunities to run away. The big mystery is why she's so interested in other missing girls when her captor is dead. I wasn't disappointed when the mystery was solved.

This is my first Lisa Gardner book and somehow, I seem to have started at the 8th book in an eight-book series. No matter what it is an excellent read as a standalone. There are enough reviews that you don't need me to reiterate what others have said. Let me just add my 2 cents that the author does a brilliant job of taking the worst, most horrifying kind of subject matter and relating the story in a readable way. No lingering on horror or gratuitous wallowing in nihilistic depravity. This, to me, is the sign of a true artist; the suspense is ratcheted up to 11 without making the reader live through horrifying violence. (There is some but it's minimal and appropriate. No torture.) The finest sort of psychological thriller. Bravo! Also awesome: it is a tale of redemption, too.

This book was a spine-tingling page-turner in every sense of the word. One of the best books I've read in years...and I read A LOT of books in this, my favorite, genre. I was completely spell-bound and captivated by Flora's harrowing experiences from the first chapter of this story onward. Literally that first chapter grabbed me by the shoulders and shook me uncontrollably all the way to my core...and I pretty much remained that way until the end. So, if you're looking for a story that will make your heart palpitate with fear and shatter into a million pieces, your stomach twist and convulse with repulsion, your skin crawl beneath the touch of evil, and your mind be blown to shreds by the twists in the plot, then this is the book for you. The bad guy, Jacob, takes on a level of abomination that I simply cannot fathom. He's a monster who, in my heart and soul, I could never imagine really exists; however, my mind and conscience keep reminding me that he could be sitting in the big rig parked beside me right now...an absolutely paralyzing thought! I'm so thankful for

writers like Lisa Gardner who can take such a nefarious character and twist him like a writhing snake through the lives of so many innocent people in a way that seems completely genuine. I'm a fan...on the edge of my seat! Absolutely cannot wait for the next book in this detective series.

I love Lisa Gardner's writing but this book was just too dark for me. I realize all of her books are dark, but this was unrelenting. I may be more sensitive because I have daughters, but I would like to read something without horrifying crimes against women.

Lisa Gardner has written another thriller featuring her favorite detective, DD Warren and a scary story of kidnapping and illegitimate incarceration, in a coffin, no less. But the victim turns out to be pretty clever herself, and gets herself out of some tight spots with DD's help. This book is not for the light of heart, as it depicts in vivid detail what it is like to be kidnapped and treated terribly poorly throughout your ordeal. But I really liked the intricate plot and the usual surprises that Gardner builds in to her stories.

I am a big fan of Lisa Gardner but I found this psychological piece too dark for me. Given the nature of the psychological issues, I couldn't relate to the characters and found it disturbing yet tedious.

This book had me gripped from the first sentence! What a way to start a book, and it just got better and better from there! Without giving away the plot, I will say there is a woman who has been abducted, and ends up being lucky enough to get out of her situation to become a vigilante to her captors. I will say no more. I hate myself, I feel I have said too much, but I just had to tell you so you'll READ THIS BOOK!!!! **EXCELLENT READ**
