

Sidebars address relevant issues, such as racism and the high lead content in the soil, while the main text chronologically narrates the storm's onset, the devastation it left behind, and the cleanup efforts that ensued. "Hurricane Katrina" provides a good overall overview of that disaster, including both scientific and

human aspects to the story, and a number of interesting photographs. While a bit inaccurate in some areas (eg. it "soft-pedals" the rationale for levee collapse), the emphasis is on providing enough detail to be useful without getting the intended audience (school pupils, and their parents) embroiled in the hot politics of who failed to do what, etc. The book also provides a timeline overview, Internet sources for further information, and credible (but not overburdening) endnotes.
