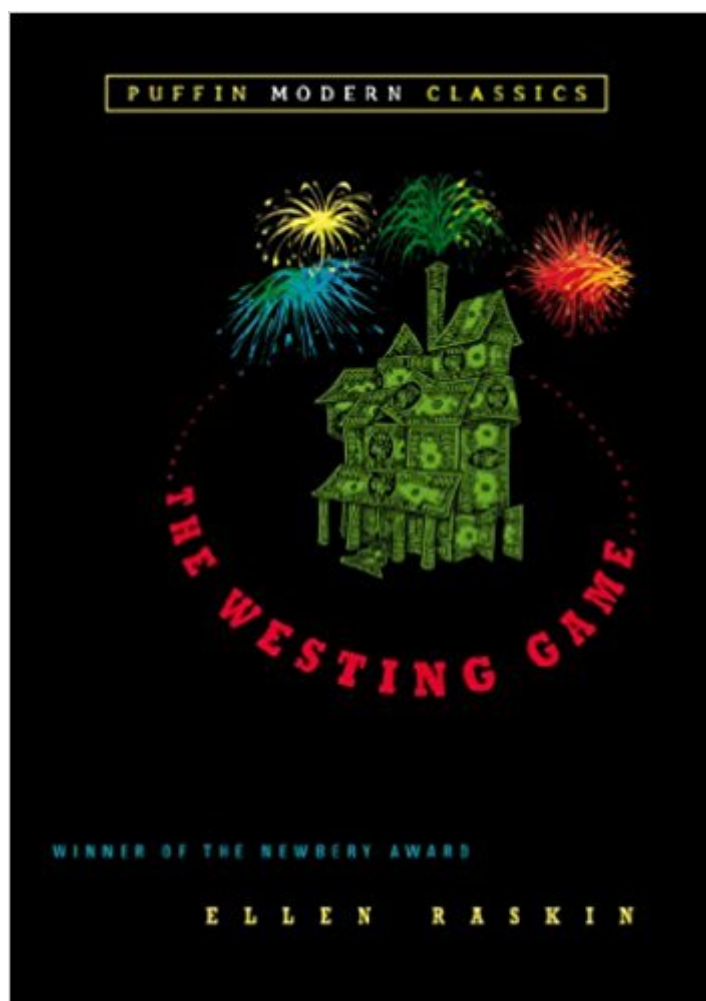

Ellen Raskin was born in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, and grew up during the Great Depression. She was the author of several novels, including the Newbery Medal-winning *The Westing Game*, the Newbery Honor-winning *Figgs & Phantoms*, *The Tattooed Potato* and other clues, and *The*

Mysterious Disappearance of Leon (I Mean Noel). She also wrote and illustrated many picture books and was an accomplished graphic artist. She designed dust jackets for dozens of books, including the first edition of Madeleine L'Engle's classic *A Wrinkle in Time*. Ms. Raskin died at the age of fifty-six on August 8, 1984, in New York City.

As a kid, this was one of my favorite books, as an adult, I still think back to this book. I read it for the first time in 5th grade, it's kind of like *Clue*. It has lots of characters ranging from kids, to older people all trying to figure out who the heir of the Westing Fortune is. Really fun book!
