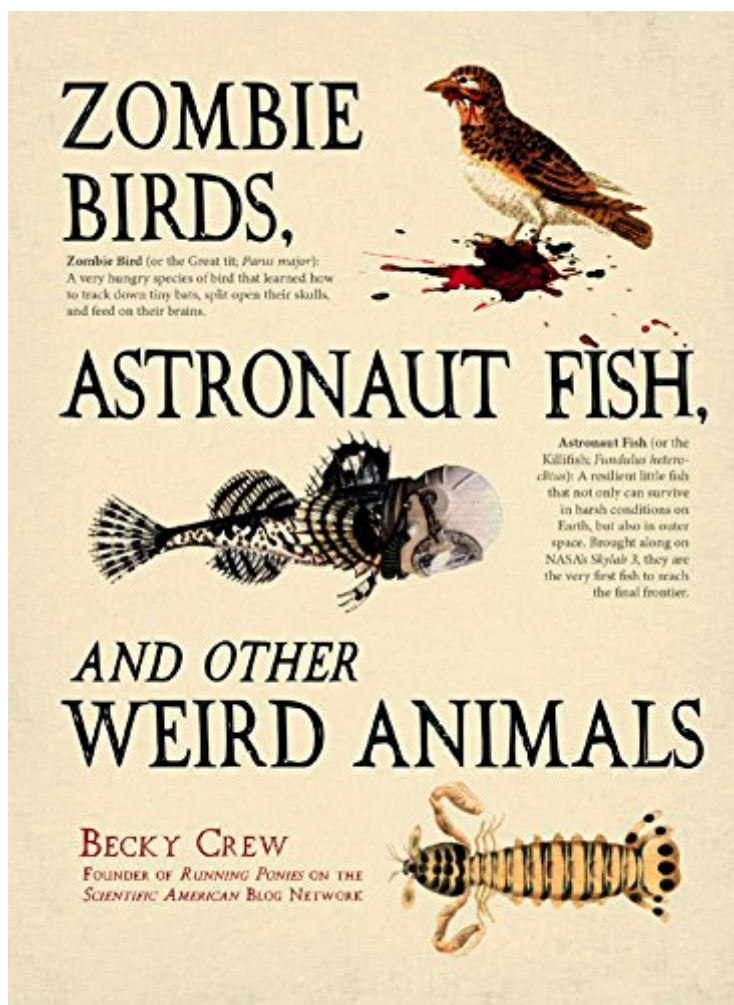

Not really saying anything that hasn't been said in the comments below. The stories, facts, and trivia are very interesting, but the vulgar (and at times outright obscene) language in the book make this unsuitable for the children who would otherwise be a major part of this book's audience. The author

seems to be under the impression that if she swears enough in the book, people will find it amusing and engaging. While I at any rate was not amused or engaged by it, and indeed I felt that it detracted from the otherwise very interesting stories that she was trying to tell.

Humor was at times hit and miss for me but, that's just personal as my wife found it all quiet funny. Over all great book, interesting subject mater, and well written. I don't know who her target audience is, but it is not your junior high kid who otherwise might be interested in zombie birds. Ms. Crew drops the "F" bomb in the introduction and throws at least one four-lettered surprise into each of the chapters I luckily previewed instead of handing it to my son to read. I had to get rid of it. I'm sorry, but this otherwise interesting book will not be welcome on my home library shelf.

I read about this book in Scientific American and it sounded intriguing. As a public school science teacher I hoped to learn some interesting facts and maybe even have some read aloud sections for my classes. The animals were indeed interesting, but the "anthropomorphic stories" were so full of profanity and laced with sexual references that there is NO WAY I'll be reading it to my students! Besides the potty humor, the informal style of the creative interludes was very off-putting. Some might find the casual hipster/modern valley girl/ slang talk style artsy or entertaining, but for me it simply was annoying. The premise had much potential. I'd like to see the work redone in a PG-13 version and with a more standard conversational style for the creative parts. I guess I should have checked out the authors blog before buying.

The core of each of the 50 entries (think blog posts) is an interesting, usually accurate, and

generally entertaining and educational short article. I'd give them a solid 4. However, interspersed with the articles are flights of fantasy that some might find amusing but I found simply a waste of paper. The first of these digressions, which also serves as the Introduction, unnecessarily drops the f-bomb, making the book unsuitable for school-age readers. On average it earns a 2. Re-print it with the paper-wasting and obscenity dropped and it would climb to a 4.
