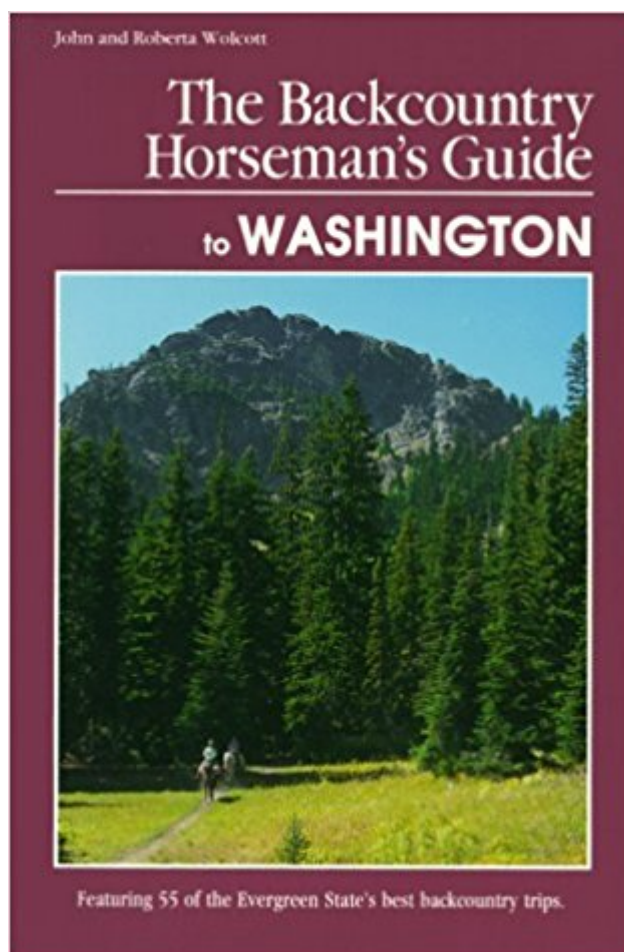

Trail riding is a great way to relax and see Washington's beautiful backcountry. Featured in this guide are fifty-five trail rides in some of the state's most scenic country. Each description has directions to the trailheads and information on horse facilities and maps.

It takes many reference books to make a collection, this is one of mine. Helpful information but limited to specific areas. Could have included a map as a reference to areas reviewed but worth the money. There's no book available that would include all the horse trails and camps in Washington.

The Backcountry Horseman's Guide to Washington by the Wolcotts is not only very useful for the 55 horse trails it lists, but it also includes a description of the facilities, food and water availability, travel and logistical tips, and trail etiquette. They also advocate "leave no trace" camping and explain how to achieve that. What a great little book!

Book is older but there is some great information in it. Well worth the price.
