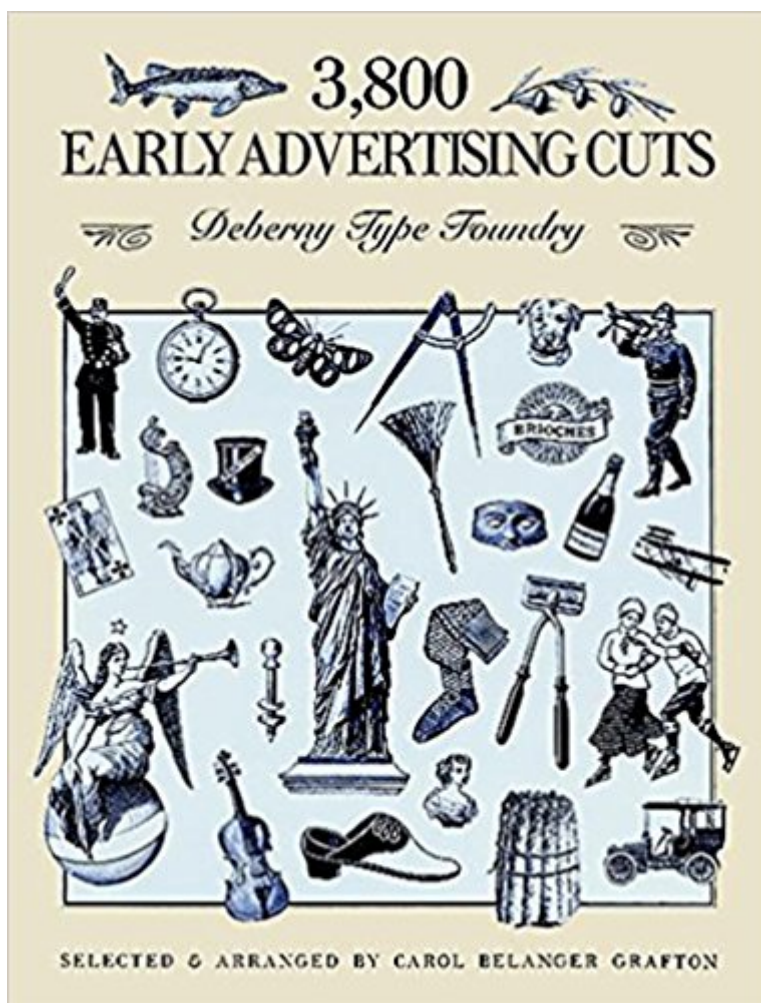

So I found the 3,800 illustrations a bit misleading, as maybe a hundred of them or more are repeats. It's definitely not 3,800 unique drawings. A lot of them are really small drawings too. So, eh, it's okay.
