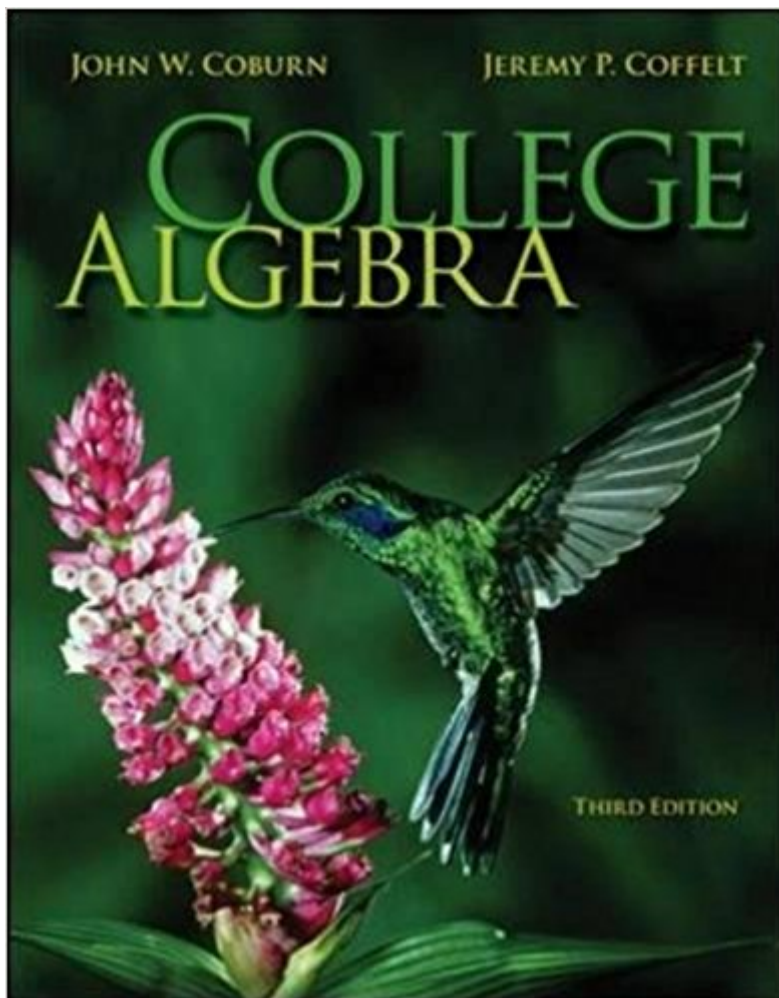

John Coburn grew up in the Hawaiian Islands, the seventh of sixteen children. He received his Associate of Arts degree in 1977 from Windward Community College, where he graduated with honors. In 1979 he received a Bachelor's Degree in Education from the University of Hawaii. After being lured into the business world for five years, he returned to his first love, accepting a teaching position in high school mathematics where he was recognized as Teacher of the Year in 1987. Soon afterward, the decision was made to seek a Masters Degree, which he received two years later from the University of Oklahoma. For the last fifteen years, he has been teaching mathematics at the Florissant Valley campus of St. Louis Community College, where he is now a full professor. During his tenure there he has received numerous nominations as an outstanding teacher by the local chapter of Phi Theta Kappa, two nominations to Who's Who Among America's Teachers and was recognized as Teacher of the year in 2004 by the Mathematics Educators of Greater St. Louis (MEGSL). He has made numerous presentations and local, state and national conferences on a wide variety of topics. His other loves include his family, music,

athletics, games and all things beautiful, and hopes this love of life comes through in his writing, and serves to make the learning experience an interesting and engaging one for all students.

This book, although brand new and in the package, did not come with an access code. I spoke to those in the corporate office of Aleks, as this book was manufactured and marketed as a companion piece to the Aleks online learning system. I was informed that yes, indeed the book is supposed to include Aleks access. And for the price, \$190.00, why wouldn't it? I contacted . They offered repayment of my money, either on gift card or back on my debit card. I chose debit card, considering I must now find somewhere else to buy the book. repaid me with gift card balance. I called to straighten it out. They could not correct the mistake. So disappointing. And, now I'm almost a month behind in my Penn State course. Thanks for nothing, .

This is a terrible book to use unless accompanied by a lot more instructions. The information in the book is very brief and doesn't adequately address the topics in my opinion. I ended up dropping the math class that used this book because the time spent with the book outside the classroom was often wasted searching for details on how to work problems - many hours were wasted without learning anything of value.

This book is terrible when it comes to teaching yourself how to do the work. It provides no explanations on how to work the problems step by step. As far as renting goes, this does not have a "MyLab" code, so if you are going to need the code you should check if you need the book, otherwise you will spend extra money on that. If you are going to have an instructor teach you, then this book is okay, as long as the instructor is a good teacher. Otherwise, when it comes to teaching yourself this book is going to be a pain.

I have taken many a college classes, included several math classes, and have generally done very well in all of them. It is difficult to find a good math textbook, but this one, above all, is by far the worst written math textbook I have ever encountered. To introduce concepts, the book provides one brief example then proclaims you ready to perform the assigned questions at the end of the chapter. The examples are crammed into a tiny text box and are not helpful at all! The examples are difficult to follow and the author does not provide several examples to show the different scenarios in which the concepts can arise. In short, this is one of the worst textbooks I've ever had.

The book is falling apart! I know it's a rental but I need it to last for my 8 week course. Im scared it's going to fall apart on me. I paid almost \$40 to be able to use this book but I'm not able to even take it to class without it falling apart! Just turning the pages is difficult.

The authors do not provide much explanation for formulas or problems, so it is likely that students will require additional assistance in order to learn the concepts.
