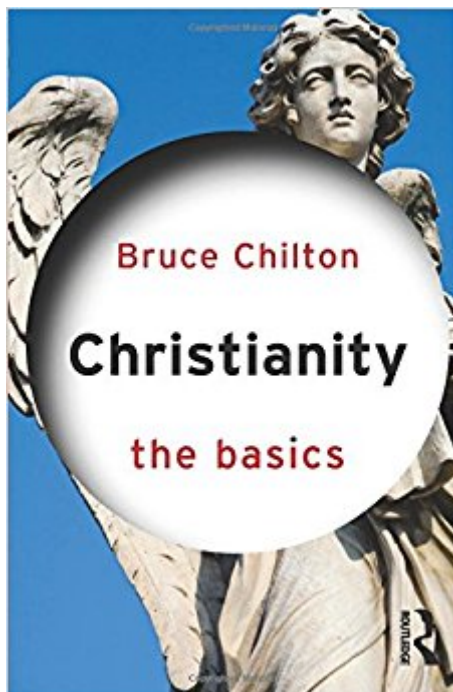

Bruce Chilton is a leading scholar of early Christianity and Judaism and is currently Bernard Iddings Bell Professor of Religion at Bard where he also directs the Institute of Advanced Theology. He has taught in Europe at the Universities of Cambridge, Sheffield, and Münster, and in the United States at Yale University (as the first Lillian Claus Professor of New Testament).

This book is not 'basic' enough and is in fact a bit odd and idiosyncratic, and it presumes too much prior knowledge in the reader. I have read scores of these books over the years, looking for suitable titles for introductory university classes. This is not the book to use. And really, it's simply not very readable. The same critique goes for the other books in this 'basics' series, although they are all

written by different people.
