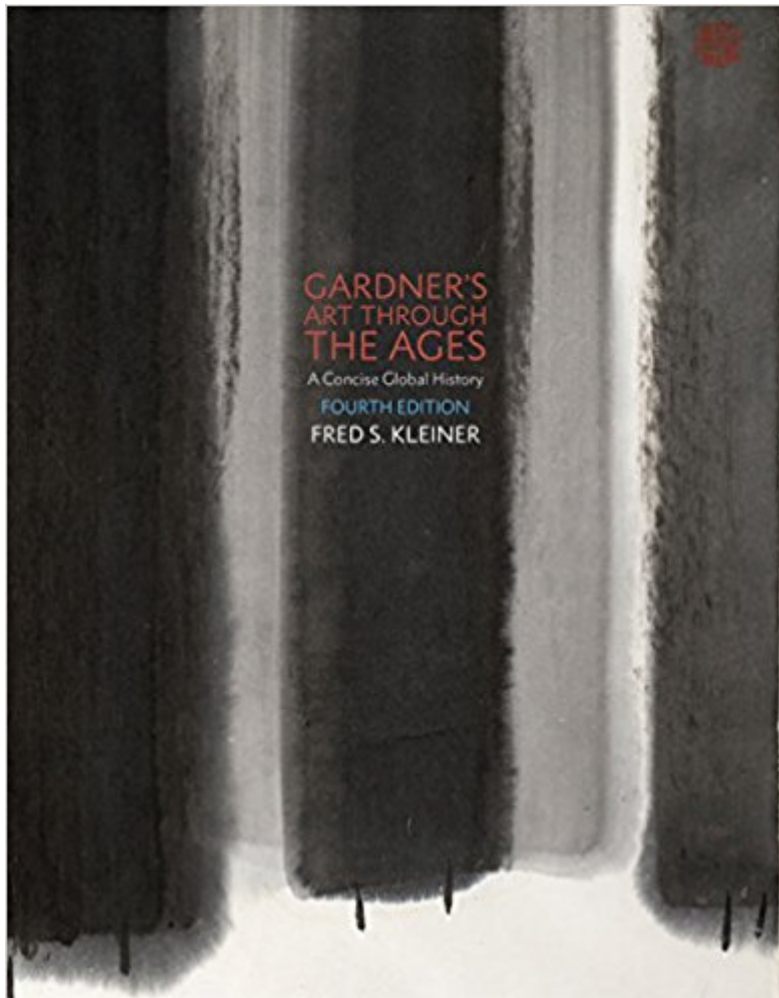

In 2007, he was elected fellow of the Society of Antiquaries of London, and, in 2009, in recognition of lifetime achievement in publication and teaching, fellow of the Text and Academic Authors Association.

I had to buy this book for my art history class. I enjoyed the book it was not boring like your usual textbooks. Pictures were wonderful.

The book is a bit dry and dull and sometimes I don't understand what is being talked about (e.g. all the structural elements of Gothic cathedrals, despite diagrams). But there are ample pictures of the art, which is good (though sometimes they're too small so you can't see the details which are being written about in the text). My professor follows this book closely, so it's good in this regard. I read the chapter, then she elaborates and shows slides in class further elaborating and explaining what I've read. This is not an art history book I'd read on my own for pleasure.

This is a great textbook for anyone taking an art history course. It's very thorough in its descriptions of famous works and provides great historical context. The book also has an extensive glossary of artists and terms in the back making it the perfect choice, even for non-majors. The seller said there were no marks or scratches anywhere in or on the book and I'm happy to report that they were absolutely right. The book arrived in perfect condition and it now accompanies me to Starbucks at least once a week.
