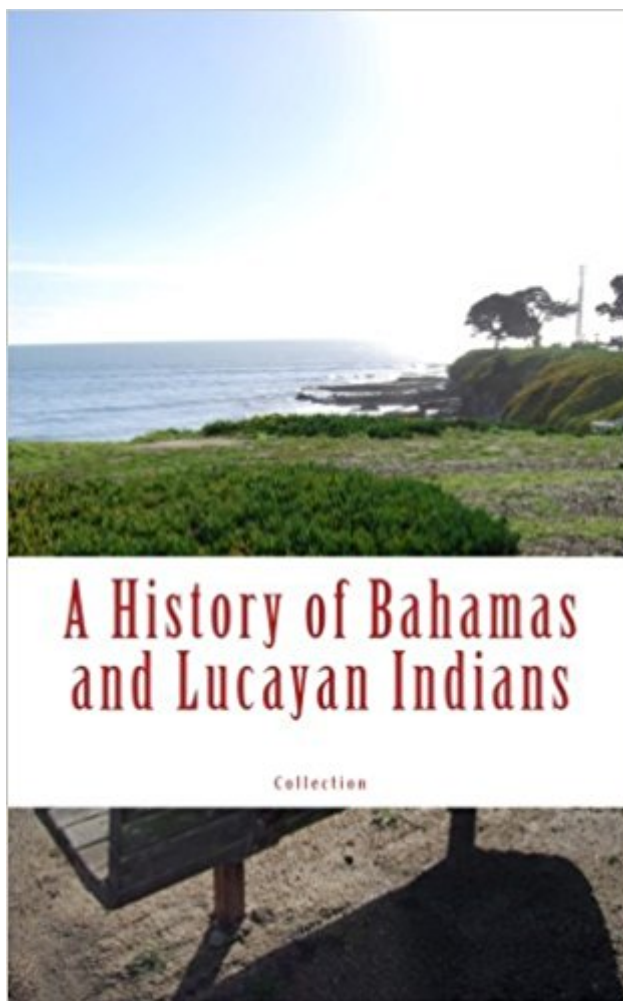

Seems to be a self-published book, without the touch of a professional editor. The paragraphs do not flow well, and in some cases, the work seems a copy-and-paste from various sources effort. The writing needs improvement, and because of the lack of clear editing, including run-on sentences, improper grammar, and redundancy, I felt hesitant to trust the information.
